### Footnotes

PEACH BRANDY dueled for the lead while two wide, was in a long drive on the turn far turn, dug in throughout in the stretch and drew off in late stretch. YURA DAISY IF U DO was settled in the early going, was blocked heading into the far turn then angled out to be four wide on the far turn, lugged in mid stretch bumping with CLASSIC KEY BRIDGE then was gaining ground to be second best. SHEZA FAST MOMMA was settled early on then rallied heading into the far turn while four wide, gained a narrow lead in upper stretch but came up empty in late stretch. BURNINGRICH was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn, moved out to be two wide then was blocked and angled out in mid stretch then was gaining ground but was no menace. CLASSIC KEY BRIDGE was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn, moved out to be three wide and was gaining ground, was forced in and forced to steadied off heels in mid stretch losing all chance. ST. PATSY was allowed to settle then rallied three wide on the far turn, made a bid to mid stretch then flattened out in late stretch. KENZIE MARIA dueled for the early lead while inside, was used up then gave way on the far turn. PERSONAL A. T. M. was unhurried early while racing on the inside then was no threat. WILDCAT CALLIE was unhurried early while racing three wide on the backstretch but was no factor. TORY'S TRIUMPH stumbled badly at the start and was pulled up by her rider then was vanned off. A stewards inquiry was held concerning the stretch run. After reviewing the films, the stewards disqualified YURA DAISY IF U DO from second and was placed fifth for interference in the stretch.
