REBEL SKY stalked the early pace while racing three wide, rallied heading into the turn and took command on the far turn, was in a long sustained drive and drew away, was kept to a hard drive and held sway in the end. HERESYOURPLAYMATE dueled for the lead while two wide, was in a long drive throughout then gamely dug in throughout the stretch and was second best in the end. BOREGO'S BARBARIAN was allowed to settle while inside, moved to the outside and rallied three wide on the far turn, made a strong bid then hung in late stretch. T HALL stalked the pace while racing inside on the backstretch then made a bid at the top of the stretch two wide but was no menace in the stretch. HE'SUPINTHESMOKE dueled for the lead while inside, was hard used then gave way on the far turn. ROAD RAGE ATTITUDE was unhurried early then raced three wide in the stretch but was no menace. SEEKINGACURE was carried out on the first turn then was no threat. NORTH WASHINGTON chased the early pace while racing two wide, was used up then gave way. DEPUTY DEHERE bore out on the first turn then raced wide throughout and was outrun. CHA BONA bobbled after the start then was sent up and raced three wide, stopped on the far turn and was eased up in late stretch and walked off.
