COUSIN KEVIN stalked the early pace while racing two wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn to take command, drew off then was kept to a hard drive and held sway in the end. CHANGE OF ORDERS set the early pace from the inside, was in a long drive then gamely dug in but held the place safe in the end. PRATT STREET stalked the pace while racing inside, made a bid two wide on the far turn, moved out three wide in upper stretch, made a strong bid but was outfinished for the place in the end. LOW PLACES was inside on the backstretch, saved ground heading into the far turn then made a mild rally in the stretch then was bumped in late stretch. TUPELO PLAYBOY was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn, was three wide in the stretch then lugged in and bumped with LOW PLACES in late stretch. GALLOPING GAME stalked the pace while racing three wide on the backstretch, made a bid into the far turn then faltered in the stretch drive. WHY SEVENTEEN was three wide on the backstretch, rallied four wide on the far turn but failed to menace. ALONG THE COAST raced three wide on the backstretch then failed to be a factor.
