WHAT AN HONOR , away alertly, went clear nearing the half mile marker, set the pace under nice rating, widened when shoved on mid turn and proved much the best while ridden out. KAS IM NOSEY , three wide, moved closer into the turn, chased the winner around the turn and finished willingly to be second best. SONG PRODUCTION was sent up early, came under pressure leaving the turn and got the show between rivals. IDE COST PENNIES , pinched back at the break, raced three wide nearing the lane and failed to menace. TENSAS TAMER stalked the early pace, dropped in towards the rail around the turn and weakened. HUFF'S PRINCESS was outrun. JILLIAN'S GETAWAY , wide, was no threat. WILD WHISPERS rated in a stalking position along the rail for three furlongs then faded under some nudging
