GENEROUS MAN pressed the pace, saved ground around the turn and got up in time. THE GREAT GYPSY went to the front, drove clear and was caught at the wire. STORMY PHANTOM raced near the back, gained ground, but was no match for the top two. MARGARITA CITY pressed the pace, hung and was outfinished for third. DUCKNDODGIN lacked early speed, moved up, but was no factor. RAYS TRICK raced within contention and faded. TIMELY MINARDI raced in the middle of the field, came around the turn four wide and faded. LATCH LIGHTING void of early speed and showed little.
