TUNNEL TIME raced near the back in the early part, saved ground around the final turn, made a bid and proved no match for the top two. SUDIE'S FANCY GIRL raced in the back of the pack, improved position, but was no factor. WIRE ME MILLIE lacked early speed, moved up and hung. GOLD CASE MOTEL raced in the middle of the field and faded. BLAKE'S CAT pressed the pace and dropped back.
