ETHANHAUL showed good early speed to set the pace, was well rated on the run down the backstretch then drew off in upper stretch while leading throughout. GAMMA RAY chased the early pace while inside, made a bid on the far turn then raced evenly in the stretch while not gaining on the winner. SILVER NICKEL was allowed to settle in the early going then rallied three wide on the far turn, moved up in late stretch but was no menace in the end. EAST COAST SWING was inside and saving ground on the first turn then stayed inside throughout, made a bid on the far turn but was no menace in late stretch. BUST AND LOOSE was unhurried early while inside, made a bid on the far turn while two wide then made a mild gain in the stretch but was no menace. NO REGRET chased the early pace while three wide, was used up then gave way on the far turn. ISEEZYA was unhurried early while four wide on the far turn but was no threat. PRINCE TYLER chased the early pace while three wide, was used up then gave way. WHY BILL WHY was allowed to settled then raced four wide on the far turn and was no menace. RODEO RACER broke in the air and trailed.
