Footnotes

JULIE'S RED BANDIT chased the pace, advanced three wide on the far turn, led in the stretch and lasted under pressure. HITNOTIQ saved ground the first turn while unhurried, raced wide turning for home and rallied nicely. NOAH'S TRAVELER rallied between horses. LITTLEBITSUPER set the pace in the two path and tired late. DYNAPAC , unhurried early, raced wide on the far turn and lacked the needed late response. EVACUEE , no factor, passed tired horses. EVACUATION , no threat, raced evenly. MAUS N AROUND had speed along the rail and weakened the final furlong. LIVINGSTONBELLE was outrun. G. W.'S SILVER was outrun.
