AGENT JONES pressed the pace, came around the turn four wide, made a bid, racing five wide and got up in time. LORI'S DREAM raced within contention, made a late bid and was outfinished for the win. LET THE BUCK RIDE broke out, raced in the back, made a late bid, six wide and finished willingly. ONE TO BOOT vied for the early lead, forwardly placed throughout and weakened late. KIPPER IN SPACE showed early speed and faded. TOM DICK OR HARRY pressed the early pace, came around the turn four wide and faded. KY SUNNY CAT lacked early speed and was never a factor. POLY SAUCE raced near the back, saved ground around the turn and lacked a bid. THOMPSON CREEK challenged for the early lead, saved ground and retreated. TEETOP void of early speed and showed little.
