Footnotes

CRAFTY NOBLE was allowed to settle in the early going, rallied on the far turn and swung out to be four wide in upper stretch, was in a strong drive and drew away in the end. SIR VALIDATOR vied for the lead while between rivals, gained command heading into the far turn and drew off in upper stretch but weakened in late stretch. NERVES OF STEEL was allowed to settle while inside on the backstretch, made a bid staying to the inside on the far turn to mid stretch but came up empty in late stretch. BAYOU VERMILION was allowed to settle while inside, rallied heading into the far turn and moved out to be three wide in upper stretch but flattened out in the drive. TOOLIGHT'S NEPHEW was unhurried early then started a run on the far turn, was blocked behind rivals and angled inside, made a mild rally while three wide in the stretch but was no menace. S P WARRIOR was allowed to settle while inside on the backstretch then failed to menace. KING CHARGER was unhurried early then raced four wide on the far turn and was no menace. DO THE CONGA danced for the lead while racing three wide on the first turn and backstretch, gained the lead heading into the far turn then gave way. STAR ELETE was allowed to settle then was no factor. ANGEL'S CHARIOT vied for the lead while inside, was used up on the backstretch and stopped on the far turn.
