Z'S COURT was allowed to settle then rallied on the far turn while two wide, moved out to be three wide in upper stretch and quickly took command and drew away in the end. SOLDIER'S VENTURE dueled for the lead while inside, was in a long drive on the far turn and stretch but tired in late stretch while saving the place in the end. BOSTON BUDDY was unhurried early then rallied three wide on the far turn, swung out to be four wide in upper stretch and was gaining ground to finished well. DILLON'S GOLD IDEA dueled for the lead while two wide, was in a long drive then weakened in the stretch drive. BATSON was inside and saving ground throughout but failed to menace in the stretch. CHRISAGOGO was settled then made a four wide bid on the far turn but flattened out in the drive. AFTERNOON MAN broke slowly from the gate then was settled, made a mild rally but was no threat. ART SHIFT chased the pace while racing three wide on the backstretch, was used up then gave way. E Z VIEW was outrun. BELLE'S INTEREST bore out on the first turn and was no factor.
