### Footnotes

SUSPECT SARA was settled in the early going then rallied two wide on the turn, was in a strong drive and drew off in late stretch. LANDSLIDE SUE was settled then rallied four wide on the turn, was gaining ground and was second best. ALLISON'S DREAM set the early pace, drew off heading into the turn, was used up and weakened in late stretch. TOUGHTRIX was bumped hard at the start then was settled, rallied three wide in the stretch and made a mild gain in the end. SORCERER'S CHARM was inside and saving ground on the turn but was no menace in the stretch. JUSTATINYLITLDREAM was unhurried early then raced four wide in the stretch and was no menace. KRUZINFORKRYSTON was allowed to settle then raced two wide on the turn and failed to respond. VOODOO ONDA BAYOU was bumped hard and pinched back at the start then was no factor. MISS GENNIE WOULD chased the early pace while two wide, was used up and gave way. POOKIE'S PRINCESS showed brief speed then stopped.
