VICTORIOUS BROAD was in tight on the first turn while inside, was shuffled back then moved out three wide for the run down the backstretch, rallied four wide on the far turn, drew off in upper stretch and was kept to a drive in the end. LUCY E. was unhurried early then rallied four wide in the stretch, was gaining ground and was second best. SWEET LEXI was in tight on the first turn then raced on the inside down the backstretch, made a bid into the far turn then raced evenly in the stretch drive. JAKE'S TUITION set pressured pace then drew off on the backstretch, was used up and gave way in the stretch drive. ACTING FRENCH was allowed to settle then rallied three wide on the far turn, made a bid but was no menace in the stretch. KENZIE'S A DEELITE was inside and saved ground on the far turn then failed to menace. BEFORE HER TIME raced four wide on the backstretch, bore out on the far turn then eased up in late stretch. SHIMMERING PORT was unruly in the gate then was settled, rallied five wide on the far turn but was no menace in the stretch drive. COURT THE PRINCESS was unhurried early then raced three wide on the far turn and was no factor. SHEEZ LEAVIN chased the early pace while two wide, was used up and stopped heading into the far turn.
