Footnotes

SO MUCH MORE was an early factor, racing behind CAT'S CAT, forwardly placed throughout, made a bid down the final stretch and proved the best late. CAT'S CAT went to the front, saved ground, led until late, couldn't hold off the winner at the wire. MISS CONFUSION pressed the pace, moved up on the rail around the final turn, checked repeatedly, getting in tight quarters, angled out and finished willingly. FUSE IT raced within contention, came around the final turn on the outside and finished evenly. TOOK OUT void of early speed, improved position, but was no factor. SALZURITA (ARG) raced in the middle of the field and put forth an even effort. JESTER RAHAB lacked early speed and was never close. DUE TO WIN always raced near the back and showed little. BRUNILDA (ARG) raced near the middle of the pack, checked around the first, getting in tight quarters and was no threat. BAILEYS AFFAIR stumbled at the start, raced near the middle of the field, then retreated to the rear.
