HARLAN STREET raced near the back at the start, moved up down the backstretch, raced within contention, took the lead on the inside around the second turn, drove clear down the lane and won under urging. STONEHOUSE unhurried in the beginning, raced four wide around both turns, made a late bid and was a clear second. SPOTSGONE vied for the early lead, came around the final turn three wide and proved no match for the top two. QUE PASO raced in the back of the pack, improved position, but was no factor. Z HUMOR brushed at the start, raced within contention, came around the final turn four wide and faded. EZ DREAMER broke in, challenged for the early lead and dropped back.
