SALTY ROMANCE quickly went to the front, drove clear, racing easily on the front, led throughout, let out down the home stretch and pulled away, being ridden out. QUESTIONABLE PAST unhurried in the beginning, moved up on the outside around the final turn, made a bid, but proved no match for the winner. TURN TO LASS pressed the early pace, forwardly placed throughout and finished willingly inside. CRYPTOS' BEST lacked early speed, moved up outside around the final turn and made a mild bid. ROSE HUNTER lacked early speed, racing four wide around the first turn, improved position, but was no factor. WACKY PATTY pressed the early pace, saved ground around the second turn and faded. FAMILY FAVORITE raced evenly near the back and was no threat. STAR'S KANDI KANE raced within contention and was finished early. SILVER CROWN raced in the middle of the field, then dropped back. IN ROME lacked early speed, raced five wide around the first turn and was never close.
