Pre-Entries will close November 21, 2008 by usual time of closing. All horses must Pre-Enter to remain eligible. Supplemental nominations will be \$10,000 to Pre-Enter on November 21, 2008 (before entries close) \$3,250 to Enter, and \$3,250 to start. Horses not drawing a post position in the gate will receive a refund of all Entry and Pre-Entry fees. Awards will be presented to the winning Owner, Trainer, and Jockey.

BIG DRAMA pressed the pace, forwardly placed throughout, took the lead entering the final turn, drove clear and held on well. WEST SIDE BERNIE unhurried in the early part, racing in the middle of the field, made a late bid, moving up strong around the final turn, couldn't get to the winner, but held on for second. STIMULUS PLAN void of early speed, racing in the rear, moved up, three wide around the final turn, made a late bid and finished willingly. RETAP pressed the early pace and weakened. TERRAIN challenged for the early lead, forwardly placed until turning for home, fading down the stretch. KICK ON raced within striking distance and faded. SKIPADATE raced evenly near the back and was never a threat. VALID MESSAGE void of early speed and showed little. TRINITY MAGIC raced near the back and was outrun. THREE PART HARMONY was an early factor, dropped back around the final turn and was pulled up down the home stretch.
