### Footnotes

PERILOUS CROSSING was settled on the inside on the run down the backstretch, started a run into the far turn while saving ground, waited for racing room in the middle of the far turn then slipped through in upper stretch, quickly moved up to take command and was in a strong drive to be best in the end. MARQUIS MARKSMAN was allowed to settle then rallied three wide on the far turn, gained command in the middle of the far turn to upper stretch but was no match for the winner in late stretch. MY TWISTER was unhurried early then rallied four wide on the far turn, was gaining ground on the outside and finished well. M. V. P. HONOR dueled for the lead while inside, was in a long drive on the far turn then weakened in late stretch. SHOEFLY SHOEFLY was unhurried early then rallied and moved out to be six wide for the stretch but was no menace while making up ground in the end. OPENING SHOW was settled in the early going then rallied and made a quick move, angled out to be two wide in the middle of the far turn to upper stretch then flattened out in the stretch. TAKE THE TOWN stalked the pace while racing three wide on the backstretch, was used up entering the far turn and gave way. NOCHANGENWEATHER was hard to load then sent to the front to duel for the lead while two wide, was used up and stopped entering the far turn. MUSICMEISTER showed brief foot while four wide, was used up and stopped then was eased up throughout the stretch drive.
