SPARKLING KEAT was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn while four wide, was in a hard drive then drew off in mid stretch and was kept to a drive. DA WEELER set a pressured pace from the inside, was in a long drive then weakened in late stretch but was second best in the end. MAY SING THE BLUES was allowed to settle then rallied four wide on the far turn, made a bid to mid stretch but came up empty in late stretch. CORNICELLI was allowed to settle then raced two wide into the far turn, angled out to be four wide then came up empty in the drive. HUJO ROUGE was unhurried early then raced three wide on the far turn, made a mild rally but was no menace in the stretch drive. DOO WAP DADDY was stalking the pace while three wide, made a bid into the far &nbsp;turn to upper stretch then flattened out in the drive. SNOOK pressed the pace while racing two wide, was hard used then gave way on the far turn. FOUR BY FOUR bore out on the first turn and was steadied off rivals heels, raced up and was inside on the far turn but weakened in the stretch. RAILROAD SHOW stalked the early pace while inside on the backstretch, was used up then gave way on the far turn. I'D BE A SECRET was pinched back at the start then failed to menace.
