Footnotes

MR. PORTER was settled early on while racing two wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn then was in a long sustained drive and under strong left handed urging prevailed in the end. VALID STRIPES allowed to settle then rallied heading into the far turn, moved out to be four wide on the far turn, gained a slim lead in upper stretch then lead in upper stretch, was in a long hard drive but could not last in the end. ROYAL HAY PATCH was bumped at the start then stalked the pace while two wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn to gain a slim lead between calls then came up empty in the stretch drive. BRENDYN JO was in tight early on and shuffled back from between rivals, was settled then rallied four wide on the far turn but raced evenly in the stretch drive. SEA THE SOLDIER set the early pace and drew off on the first turn, was used up and gave way on the far turn. SLIGO JOE broke in at the start and bumped then was unhurried early, stayed inside and failed to menace. TEXAS BIRDSTONE was allowed to settled while racing on the inside down the backstretch then gave way.
