MEDIEVAL JAZZ pressed the pace, made a bid around the final turn, took command and was going away at the end. MISS CAJYN raced within contention, made a late bid, proved no match for the winner, but got up for second. NOBLE DELIGHT vied for the lead, forwardly placed throughout and was outfinished for second. KISSIN KENDALL lacked early speed, made a late bid, steadied down the final stretch, getting in tight quarters and finished evenly. STAR AGENDA raced near the middle of the field, came around the final turn on the outside and lacked a late rally. PARIS PRIDE void of early speed, moved to the rail and was never a factor. GLAMOUR SHOT always raced near the back and showed little. MADELYNN ROAD raced within contention, came around the first turn three wide and retreated. GOODBYE BEAUTIFUL dueled on the front end and stopped.
