SUPRAMAN was allowed to settled while two wide on the first turn, rallied two wide into the far turn then was in along hard drive and drew off in late stretch. DEACON BOB was unhurried early then rallied three wide on the far turn, was gaining ground and was up for the place in the strides. KRAZY KERRI set the pace from the start, drew off on the run down the backstretch, was used up on the far turn and weakened in the stretch drive. G. FACTOR was unruly in the gate then angle din on the first turn, made a mild rally while two wide on the far turn but was no threat. WALK EVERY WALK broke very slow from the gate then settled in the early going, made a late rally while four wide in the stretch but was no threat. SWOON'S TRAVELER was inside and saving ground throughout but failed to menace. BYARSBOOGYMAN raced three wide on the backstretch and failed to menace. KILLIAN'S REVENGE was unhurried early and failed to menace. LEO BLUE was inside and no factor. JAKE'S POSTERBOY chased the early pace from the inside, was used up and stopped on the far turn.
