GO PUBLIC vied for the early lead, dueled down the home stretch with MADMAD ELAINE and proved the best late. MADMAD ELAINE challenged for the early lead, saved ground around the turn, dueled down the lane, was outfinished for the win, but held on for the place. GOOD FLAMIN FRYDIE raced near the back in the beginning, made a late bid and was outfinished for second. LYDFIRST had a tight start, pressed the pace, came around the turn three wide and lacked a late kick. WHIFFIN broke out, vied for the early lead and faded. FAREWELL BROADWAY lacked early speed, entered the home stretch wide, improved position, but was no factor. STORM DAY VISION raced evenly near the middle of the pack and was no threat. LEE'S CONQUEST lacked early speed and was never a factor. CAJUN GIFT pressed the early pace and dropped back. I'MABADBOY broke in, raced within contention, came around the turn wide, entered the stretch wide and stopped.
