ROYAL EXPRESS was allowed to settle then rallied four wide on the turn, was in a long drive on the outside in the stretch and wore down WISH YOU GOLD in deep stretch. WISH YOU GOLD set the early pace then drew off on the turn, was in a long drive then drifted out in the stretch but was caught in late stretch. BAMJAN stumbled at the start then was sent along toe be in good position while two wide, moved in slightly in the middle of the turn then rallied in upper stretch, was behind rivals and started moving up between rivals but came up empty in the end. ANGELONMYSHOULDER (GB) was unhurried early then moved out to be four wide and came with a late rally in the stretch but was no threat. TWO EX was three wide on the turn then made a bid but raced evenly in the stretch. BLUSHING ROMEO was inside heading into the turn, was in tight and checked up then raced evenly in the stretch. RUN BRICK RUN raced three wide into the turn was used up and faltered. CUSTER COUNTY was inside then lacked a rally. A stewards inquiry was held concerning the running of the race. A claim of foul was lodged by the rider of BLUSHING ROMEO against the rider of BAMJAM for interference in the middle of the turn. A claim of foul was lodged by the rider of BAMJAM against the riders of ROYAL EXPRESS and WISH YOU GOLD for interference in the stretch. After reviewing the films, no action was taken on all objections.
