JETABILITYPROSPECT was settled in the early going then was taken to the outside to be five wide on the backstretch, rallied five wide on the far turn making a bid then circled the field to gain command in upper stretch then drew off in late stretch. MARGOS WALKER was settled then rallied along the inside on the far turn, moved out making a bid two wide in upper stretch but came up empty in late stretch. WAGON TROUBLE was unhurried early then angled inside to saved ground going into the far tun, angled out to be five wide in upper stretch and was gaining ground in late stretch. NOBLE SMITH pressed the early pace from the inside then assumed command on the first turn, drew off heading into the far turn but weakened in the stretch drive. EMBRASSER was unhurried early then made a rally three wide into the far turn, moved out to be four wide in upper stretch and moved up in late stretch. COWBOY CADILLAC was unhurried early while racing four wide on the backstretch, moved out to five wide in upper stretch and failed to menace while moving up in the end. GETUSUM K. was allowed to settle while racing on the inside down the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn making a bid but came up empty in the drive. LATCH LIGHTING was allowed to settle while racing on the inside, rallied three wide into the far turn but faltered in mid stretch. PRADEROSO was allowed settled then rallied four wide on the far turn making a strong bid then flattened out in the stretch. GIVETHEBALLTOROLF

showed good early speed while two wide, was used up and stopped when entering the far turn.
