LUCILLEVILLE set a pressured pace from the inside, was in a long drive throughout and held sway in the end. LIBBIES MISSION was allowed to settled then rallied four wide on the far turn, made a strong bid to late stretch but came up empty in the end. SHE'S A MIRACLE was unhurried early then was two wide heading into the far turn, was blocked behind rivals then swung out to be five wide in upper stretch, was gaining ground and finished well in the end. ABAMA LIGHT was pressing the pace while racing two wide on the first turn, was then settled on the run down the backstretch then was shuffled back on the far turn and was no menace in the stretch. CHARGRAY bobbled at the start then was settled on the inside, was saving ground then moved out to be two wide for the stretch drive but was no menace in the end. PERDIDO'S HOLIDAY was allowed to settle then failed to menace. CAJUN ROYALE was three wide on backstretch while pressing the pace, was in a long drive then faltered in the stretch. CELLIST HANNA was four wide on the backstretch, made a bid on the outside while being used up and gave way. PRINCESS MAYA was well placed while racing on the inside then faltered on the far turn.
