LIGHTIN HAZE was unhurried early then started a run on the turn, moved out to be five wide in upper stretch and closed fast on the outside and powered to the front in late stretch. ESSENCE OF SPEED was unhurried early then rallied in upper stretch, was seven wide in the stretch and was up for place in the end. EVERY SUNDAY vied for lead while two wide, was in a long drive then was gamely in late stretch but was no menace in the end. PROLONGED vied for the lead while four wide into the turn, was in a long drive then weakened in the stretch drive. ROCKER CHAD vied for the lead while inside, drew off on the turn then weakened in the stretch. TOO FROSTY was three wide on the turn, was used up and faltered in the stretch. HIGH HAND was unhurried early then made a mild rally then was four wide in the stretch and was no menace. FINE N ADORABLE allowed to settle then raced two wide on the turn, was blocked in upper stretch and was no menace. BAD FOOTED GRADY vied for the lead while inside, was shuffled back then was eased up in late stretch.
