DO THE TIGER was inside on the turn and saving ground, angled out to be three wide in upper stretch then was in a strong drive and proved best in the end. KAS IM NOSEY was well placed while racing two wide, rallied on the turn to gain command then drew off in upper stretch and dug in gamely then tired in late stretch. IDEALIEN rallied four wide on the turn then made a bid but came up empty in late stretch. LIVELY DROP set the early pace, was used up then faltered in the stretch drive. SAVANNAH'S SHADOW was unhurried early then made a mild rally while four wide but was no threat. GIMMEALIFE was unhurried early and was no threat. LADY SYMPHONY chased the early pace while three wide, was used up and faltered. POOCHIEWOOCHIE bobbled in the early going then was pulled up by her rider on the turn and was vanned off.
