LIVE EVERY DAY was allowed to settle then rallied coming out of the far turn, moved out to be three wide and was in a strong drive and was along in time. SWEET RUSTON stalked the early pace while racing two wide, rallied on the far turn then was in a long div eon the inside of the winner but was outfinished in the final strides. CARMEN'S MYSTERY set the early pace then drew off on the backstretch, was used up and weakened in late stretch. EXCHANTED was well placed while inside, saved ground on the far turn but was no menace in the stretch. OPPORTUNITY LOST was unhurried early then raced three wide on the far turn but was no threat in the stretch drive. LITTLE WIDOW MAKER was allowed to settle while inside, stayed on the inside on the far turn but failed to menace in the stretch. LADY TAMER was allowed to settle then raced three wide on the far turn then faltered in the stretch. RUNNING SHOES was no factor.
