ESSENCE OF SPEED bobbled at the start then was well placed while two wide, rallied three wide on the turn to be in a long drive to gained command in mid stretch and proved best in the end. KEVIN'S BUDSKI duelled for the lead while two wide into the turn, drew off in upper stretch but was in a long drive and could not last in late stretch. LIGHTIN HAZE bore in slightly on the run down the backstretch, was settled while four wide into the turn then finished well in the end. THREEGUYSANAGAL was unhurried early then rallied and swung out to be five wide in upper stretch and closed willingly in late stretch. CAJUN BREW was forced in slightly on the run down the backstretch then had his heels clipped by CEASERS MARCH nearing the half mile pole, was chasing the pace while three wide then was in tight and forced to take back entering the turn, made a mild rally while three wide in the stretch but was no menace. POLY SAUCE was inside and saving ground on the turn then faltered in the stretch drive. GEE'S GLITTER bore in slightly on the run down the backstretch while dueling for the lead from the inside, was hard used on the turn then stopped in the stretch. TIGER BAIT was no factor. OPTIMIST M bore in slightly on run down the backstretch then was three wide on the turn but was outrun. CEASERS MARCH was between horses early on then forced to steadied when in tight and clipped the heels of CAJUN BREW and stumbled badly unseating the rider. A stewards inquiry was held concerning the incident on the backstretch. After reviewing the films, no action was taken.
