AND MUSIC CAME was allowed to settle while inside on the backstretch, rallied then swung out three wide on the far turn and made a quick move to go up three wide then was in a long drive and held sway in the end and established a new track record. CORAGIL CAT was settled in the early going, rallied heading into the far turn four wide, was gaining ground on the outside and finished strong in the end. MAURICEVILLE was dueled for the lead from the inside, was in a long drive then squeezed along the inside on the far turn, was shuffled back then came again in late stretch to finished well. VALID STRIPES pressed the early pace while racing three wide on the backstretch, was in a long drive and bore in nearing the top of the stretch then weakened in late stretch. MILE MARKER pressed the pace while two wide on the backstretch, was in a long drive then faltered heading into the far turn. SEAN LAFITTE broke slowly from the gate then was settled, stayed inside on the backstretch and far turn but failed to menace. WICKED VOW was unhurried early and raced four wide on the backstretch but was no threat throughout. IMA CHU CHU TRAIN was unhurried early and inside throughout while being no threat. RANDOM MOVE was unhurried early and no factor. GALLOPING HOME was no threat.
