MR. DIRECTIONAL unhurried in the early part, moved up four wide around the final turn and drove clear down the stretch. RIVER TRECK broke in, vied for the early lead, forwardly placed throughout, proved no match late for the winner, but was a clear second. PRECIOUS BEANS raced within contention, made a bid, but couldn't match strides with the top two. FLYING IDE pressed the pace and lacked a late kick. I FLY pressed the early pace and faded. GLITZ'S TIMBER lacked early speed, moved up, but was no factor. GENNES BALL bumped at the start, racing in the back, moved up, but was no threat. CAME IN FIRST always raced near the back and showed little. BULLISH HUMOR broke in, raced in the middle of the field and retreated. SPIRIT'S BACK vied for the early lead and dropped back.
