KITTY VIOLET raced within contention, took the lead around the final turn, drove clear and held on well for the win. BLAZE VENTURE was loosed before the start, raced in the middle of the field, gained ground and closed well. CHUTO'S PRINCESS broke out at the start, went to the front, drove clear and lacked a late kick. LATE CLOSING steadied early, getting in tight quarters, racing near the back and made a mild bid. DECEIVING HONEY pressed the early pace and weakened. DANCE MARY DANCE lacked early speed, improved position, but was no factor. VICTORIA GRACE raced in the middle of the field and weakened. SOLDIERS DOLL raced within striking distance and faded. LIVVY LEIGH always raced near the back and showed little. GOLD DREAM shuffled back at the start and was never close.
