Footnotes

HOPESLONGGONE unhurried in the early part, moved up, three wide around the final turn, made a bid and proved the best late. LOUISIANA VENTURE broke in, raced within contention, came around the first turn four wide, dueled late and was outfinished for the win. HOUSEBUILDER bumped at the start, vied for the lead, forwardly placed throughout and lacked a late kick. FINEST IRISH bumped at the start, vied for the early lead, saved ground around the final turn and weakened. CHARISMATICSNEPHEW lacked early speed, moved up, but was no factor. TABITHA'S BOY void of early speed, improved position, but was no threat. QUINT'S MALAGRA was an early factor and dropped back. GOING STAG raced within contention and retreated. SPLEWACIDE broke out, raced in the middle of the field and faded. WICKED VICE raced near the back, dropped to the rear, was distanced and eased.
