ACE AND JIM stalked the pace while racing three wide, rallied on the turn to take command then drew off in upper stretch and was kept to a drive in late stretch. WILBY'S RAY was unhurried early then rallied four wide on the turn, was gaining ground to be second best in the end. HUFFS HUNTER was taken back off the early pace then rallied two wide into the turn making a strong bid but came up empty in the drive. THE DIVINE TUNNEL was unhurried early then moved out and was three wide in the stretch to make up some ground but was no threat. CYA LATER BERT was unhurried early then was inside in upper stretch, angled out and passed tiring rivals in the stretch. CUSTOM JET was four wide on the turn, was used up and faltered in the stretch. EDNA'S RADE duelled for the lead from the inside, was used up then stopped. POLY SAUCE was outrun.
