Footnotes

CALL dueled for the lead while inside, was in a long drive then drew off on the turn, was all out in late stretch and held sway in the end. WHERE'S CAIN was stalking the pace while racing two wide then was blocked heading into the turn, rallied three wide in the stretch and was gaining ground to finish well. RAIL RIDGE chased the pace while inside on the turn, made a bid two wide in the stretch and was gaining ground in late stretch. LYD RIVER was well placed while racing two wide into the turn, made a bid then came up empty in late stretch. NORMANDY SHORE was unhurried early then rallied four wide on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. CLASSIC CASCADE was unhurried early then swung out to be five wide in upper stretch but was no menace in the end. OLLIE BABY raced four wide into the turn while stalking the pace, made a bid on the turn then faltered in the stretch drive. ROYAL HAY PATCH was unhurried early and was no threat. BAMJAN was no factor.
