CRESCENT CITY HERO was allowed to settled then rallied four wide on the far turn, was in a hard drive and wore down RAPID DELTA in the final strides. RAPID DELTA set the pace from the start, drew off on the far turn, was in a long drive but could not last in the final stride. FULL PARDON was unhurried early then rallied four wide on the far turn, was gaining ground but was no menace to the top two. SUESTAMER chased the early pace while racing two wide on the backstretch, made a bid but was no menace in the stretch. KILLER chased the early pace while three wide, made a bid on the backstretch then weakened in the stretch drive. B'S LUCKY CAPITAL was unhurried early while racing four wide on the far turn but was no threat. BAYOU VERMILION was unhurried early then passed tiring rivals in the stretch. SILKYS LAST DEAL was allowed to settled while racing three wide on the backstretch, bid on the far turn then faltered in the stretch. PRIVATE ROAD broke in the air at the start and was no factor. HELL OF A DAY was inside then stopped in the stretch. A stewards inquiry was held concerning the start. After reviewing the films, no action was taken by the stewards.
