GOVERNOR OF SPAIN bothered at the start, racing in the back, came around the final turn three wide and was a clear second. SILENT PLEASURE broke out at the start, raced near the back, made a late rally, but proved no match for the top two. MR. CANAVERAL pressed the early pace, saved ground around the second turn and weakened. WILD BUCK raced within contention and faded. MOODY GOOSE pressed the early pace and dropped back. BLUE SUNDAY went to the front, saved ground around the final turn and stopped.
