STORMY AMBER stalked the leader in the early going, moved up around the final turn, dueled down the stretch and drove clear before the wire. MYSTICAL MOONLIGHT went to the front, drove clear, dueled down the home stretch, proved no match for the winner, but was best of others. SUN SPUN raced within contention, made a bid around the final turn, but proved no match for the top two. TAWNKA pressed the early pace, saved ground around the final turn and lacked a late kick. MISSGALLOPINGGULCH raced within striking distance and finished evenly. DE'S SWEET DREAM raced evenly near the back and lacked a bid. PREVENTION void of early speed and was never close.
