FLASHY FOOTNOTE unhurried early from the inside, steadily advanced up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, responded along the rail and was well clear late while under steady urging. ROLL PRESLEE ROLL up close early from the outside, inched closer entering the second turn, responded to gain the advantage but could not last. SUDDEN GALE outrun early, advanced from between foes entering the second turn, responded but could only gain the show. WOMAN SOLDIER well placed from the inside, made a bid entering the second turn but could not sustain the effort. BACK IN FASHION could only improve position. LONG GONE SALLY was no factor. STRAWBERRY BALL was no threat. JAMI BABY forced the early pace outside and tired. SHE'S A LIL DELITE broke sharp from the outside, gained a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch then gave way.
