JUNGLE JUICE dueled from between foes for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, shook loose at the eighth pole and was well clear while under steady urging. MINE NOW bumped at the start, stalked the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, responded but just lasted for the place. LADY DOW far back early, advanced outside entering the turn, responded and had good energy late. ROBINETTA dueled from the outside early, battled through the turn but could not keep pace. BURNT STAR could only improve position. JUST LIKE AN ANGEL went evenly. HYDINGINDYNOSIDY was no factor. COUNTING WEST chased the early pace outside and tired. GRAND AND GREY was no threat. STORMING MIRAGE dueled from the inside and gave way.
