DRINKING FUND was allowed to settle then rallied four wide on the far turn, was in a strong drive and wore down DIAMOND DONNA in the final strides. DIAMOND DONNA stalked the pace while racing three wide then rallied to take command in upper stretch, was in a strong drive but could not last in late stretch. OK ELUSIVE was unhurried early then was four wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn while four wide then was no menace in the stretch. SCAMP AND A HALF set the early pace while inside, was used up then weakened in the stretch drive. RUSTON RED was unhurried early then made a mild rally while five wide in the stretch but was no threat in the end. PEACH BRANDY chased the early pace while racing two wide on the backstretch, made a bid into the far turn but faltered in the stretch drive. THE SMART LOOK was unhurried early then started a run into the far turn, was blocked behind rivals and lacked a rally in the stretch.
