TRAIN HEIST dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn with MONGOLIAN STAR, put that one away mid stretch and was clear late while kept to task. MONGOLIAN STAR dueled from the inside for the early lead, battled through the turn, remained forward but could not match strides. DO THE CONGA up close early from the inside, made a bid entering the drive but just lasted for the show. ARISTOCRAT AGAIN outrun early, advanced outside, made a bid and finished with good energy. TIN CAT chased the early pace from the outside, made a bid but could not sustain the effort. KIPLING BOY went evenly. RICH MONARCHOS was no factor. LEESTOWN MAGIC forced the early pace inside and tired.
