Footnotes

NOBLE TRUTH rated close about the three path, dueled for the lead approaching the eighth pole and dug in determinedly from there to best the pacesetter. HUSKER NATION rated a short lead off the rail, dug in gamely to the winners' challenge from the top of the stretch but reluctantly yielded to that one the final furlong. TRUE WINK lacked room inside early after stumbling badly from the gate, angled out making a bid approaching the quarter pole and finished evenly. AVONIAN gave chase two deep but weakened through the lane. DAZZLE THEM JOE bobbled slightly at the start, gave chase off the rail but proved empty in the stretch. COOPER COUNTY broke in making contact with Mr. Commissioner leaving the gate, picked up the chase inside then weakened through the lane. MR. COMMISSIONER, bumped at the start, gave chase about the four path through the backstretch, was forced out leaving the quarter pole and weakened in the stretch. SEMI WAKI showed no speed outside.
