Footnotes

HONOR LASS was never far back, made a four wide bid on the turn, drew off in the stretch under right handed urging. LUDICROUS had no speed, dropped back to last at the quarter pole, found her best stride late and rallied along the rail. A PAR TEA close to the pace, raced between rivals, finished well. ESCOLTA settled in the middle of the back, made a four wide move on the turn, loomed briefly then flattened out. BRIEF ACCEPTANCE was allowed to settle, passed tiring rivals in the lane. ALYTRUE bobbled at the start, trailed on the backstretch, was six wide at the quarter pole, never threatened. ANNIE MCGEE dueled between rivals for the early lead, gave way in the stretch. OUR BARBETTE vied for the lead while three wide and between foes, battled into the stretch, had little left. SALT CRYSTAL dueled briefly along the rail, dropped back on the turn. A GIRL NEEDS CASH settled in the middle of the pack, showed little. WON MORO was forced to race four to five wide on the turn, lacked room turning into the stretch, never threatened.
