NOT A PROBLEM rated the pace, was tested entering the stretch and responded gamely to maintain her edge. STRICT FORUM rated off the pace, made her bid to the outside of the top contenders at the quarter pole then closed to late stretch. GRISHAM rated back off the pace, saved ground through the final turn, made a bid through the stretch and finished evenly. SWEET BLISS stalked the pace, moved alongside the pacesetter through the final turn then leveled out through the stretch without rider encouragement. CHARMER'S IMAGE, off the pace, offered no rally. TARPLAN raced just off the early pace in the four path, ducked in entering the stretch causing her rider to lose his balance and was through from there. THAT IS ALL bobbled at the start and was never a factor.
