NATIVE TUNE raced within striking distance but lacked a rally. WANNABE failed to menace. MEADOWLAKE CAPER showed little. SWORD OF DUBAI was outrun. CRIME WAVE showed little. HAIROS was through early. PACIFIC STORM pressed the early pace and tired.
