Footnotes

MARILINA rated close to the pace off the rail, advanced to position outside the top two entering the stretch, dueled to the lead near the eighth pole then moved clear under a drive. GLORIOUS TUNE was bumped at the start, raced off the pace just off the rail, made her bid angling to the rail in the upper stretch, looked a threat to midstretch then leveled out. SAYITWITHDIAMONDS stalked the pace, moved to position to the outside of the early leader on the turn, dueled onto midstretch and weakened from there. BLUSHING RAINBOW raced just off the pace in the five path, made a mild bid then leveled off. GOLDEN MONARCH set the pace, was tested through the turn, kept a short lead to midstretch then weakened. YANKEE CROSSING chased the pace and proved no threat. CORPORATE ELEGANCE angled in bumping GLORIOUS TUNE at the break, chased the pace on the rail then faded through the turn.
