SINCERELY broke alertly to dispute the pace near the inside and was under a hard drive to turn back VALLEYDAR in the final furlong. VALLEYDAR joined the winner on the first turn to match strides two wide and held on well to the end in a good try. WEEKEND KAPER, well placed along the inside, finished willingly to close the gap. RESORT was under a long drive to close gradually. PRIZED STAMP bumped at the start, advanced on the far turn and drifted out in the final furlong. MARYS PROSPECT broke awkwardly and continued well. MEGHAN'S JOY showed nothing. CHEZ ALLIE was put to a drive on the final turn to move closer then weakened in the drive. I'M JUST A PEACH bobbled outward at the start. WIRES CROSSED, early factor inside, tired.
