COMEDERO rated three wide while close up early, edged to the front at the quarter pole and prevailed after a long stretch battle. NATHAN'S H Q set a pressured pace inside, alternated for the lead then dueled to the finish in a game effort. BILLY ONE LITE was blocked between rivals nearly the entire turn then split rivals rallying too late. HOMERUN BERTI saved ground, moved closer on the turn then gradually weakened. PEPPY KNOWS bid between rivals on the turn then came up empty in the stretch. WHISTLE PIG dropped far behind early then showed some energy too late. SNEAKING UPONYOU prompted the pace in the two path then gave way after half a mile. SILVER MAGNUS rated wide off the early leaders, rallied on the turn but had no further response.
